## **INTRODUCTION**

The rules applicable to the European Globalisation Adjustment Fund (EGF) are laid down in Regulation (EU) No 1309/2013 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 17 December 2013 on the European Globalisation Adjustment Fund (2014-2020) and repealing Regulation (EC) No 1927/2006 (the 'EGF Regulation'). This Regulation covers applications for the mobilisation of the EGF submitted to the Commission after 1 January 2014.

Point 13 of the Interinstitutional Agreement of 2 December 2013 between the European Parliament, the Council and the Commission on budgetary discipline and sound financial management sets the budgetary provisions related to the EGF.

### d) Detailed grounds for the increase

In the proposal for Decision [COM(2014)560], the Commission concluded that the conditions for a financial contribution from the EGF to application EGF/2014/006 FR/PSA, submitted by the French authorities, are met.

The amount of EUR 12 704 605 requested by the French authorities will contribute to the costs of a coordinated package of eligible personalised services for 2 357 targeted beneficiaries following redundancies in Peugeot Citroën Automobiles (PSA) in France with the aim of providing assistance for re-integrating the affected persons into the labour market.

The redundancies were caused by major structural changes in world trade patterns due to globalisation.
