Subject: Case before the General Court:
- T-494/14 (Oleksandr Klymenko / Conseil)

1. By application notified to the Council on 31 July 2014, Oleksandr Klymenko has brought an action pursuant to Article 263 TFEU to annul Council Decision 2014/119/CFSP of 5 March 2014 and Council Regulation No 208/2014 of 5 March 2014 both concerning restrictive measures directed against certain persons, entities and bodies in view of the situation in Ukraine, insofar as they apply to the Applicant.
2. The applicant invokes the following grounds in support of his application:
 - a) breach of rights of defence and of the right to effective judicial;
 - b) manifest error of assessment of evidence;
 - c) failure to state reasons and misuse of powers;
 - d) breach of the right to property and the principle of proportionality.
3. The Director-General of the Council Legal Service has appointed Mr Alessandro VITRO and Jan-Peter HIX, legal advisors in the Council Legal Service, as the Council's agents in this case.
