Subject:	Working Arrangement between the Ministry of Security of Bosnia and Herzegovina and the European Police College (CEPOL)

1. The second subparagraph of Article 8(3) of Council Decision 2005/681/JHA of 20 September 2005 establishing the European Police College (CEPOL) and repealing Decision 2000/820/JHA¹, reads:

"Cooperation agreements with bodies of non-member States of the European Union can only be concluded after the approval of the Council has been obtained".
2. CEPOL's Governing Board approved the text of the Working Arrangement between the Ministry of Security of Bosnia and Herzegovina and the European Police College (CEPOL) by written procedure on 8 August 2014.
3. CEPOL submitted the text of the aforementioned draft Working Arrangement for the approval of the Council on 8 August 2014 (12639/14).
