- Case C-511/13 P - Appeal brought by Philips Lighting Poland S.A., and  
Philips Lighting B.V. against the judgment of the General Court of 11 July  
2013 in Case T-469/07

1. By application lodged with the Court of Justice on 23 September 2013 and notified to the Council on 11 October 2013, the Appellants have lodged an appeal against the judgment of the General Court in Case T-469/07 of 11 July 2013 by which the General Court dismissed Appellants' application for annulment of Council Regulation (EC) No 1205/2007 of 15 October 2007 imposing anti-dumping duties on imports of integrated electronic compact fluorescent lamps (CFL-i) originating in the People's Republic of China following an expiry review pursuant to Article 11(2) of Council Regulation (EC) No 384/96 and extending to imports of the same product consigned from the Socialist Republic of Vietnam, the Islamic Republic of Pakistan and the Republic of the Philippines (OJ L 272, 17.10.2007 at p.1).

2. By their appeal, the Appellants request that the contested judgment be set aside on the following two main grounds:

- first ground: the judgment is based on an incorrect interpretation of Article 9 (1) of the Basic Anti-dumping regulation (Council Regulation (EC) No 1225/2009 of 30 November 2009, OJ L 343, 22.12.2009 at p. 51);
- second ground: the contested judgment is based on an erroneous interpretation of articles 4 (1) and 5 (4) of the Basic Anti-dumping regulation, insofar as the definition of the "Community industry" is concerned.

3. The Director General of the Legal Service of the Council has appointed Ms. Sonja BOELAERT, legal advisor in the Legal Service of the Council, as the Council's agent in this case. She will be assisted by Mr. Bernard O'CONNOR and Mr. Sébastien GUBEL (NCTM O'Connor Brussels).
