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**Subject:** Proposal for a Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council  
establishing the Copernicus Programme and repealing Regulation (EU) No  
911/2010  
*- General approach*

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In document 16534/13, on page 11, the paragraph 4 of Article 6bis should read as follows:

4. The Commission may entrust the implementation of Copernicus to the entities set out in point (c) of Article 58(1) of the Financial Regulation (EU 966/2012). **Where Copernicus budget is implemented by indirect management on the basis of Articles 6ter (2bis) or 6quater (1), the procurement rules of the entities entrusted with budget implementation tasks should apply to the extent allowable under Article 60 of the Financial Regulation (EU 966/2012). Specific adjustments necessary to these rules should be defined in the corresponding delegation agreements.**

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
