Subject: Commission delegated regulation (EU) No .../.. of 17.7.2014 on the conditions for classification, without testing, of metal lath and beads for internal plastering covered by the harmonised standard EN 13658-1, metal lath and beads for external rendering covered by the harmonised standard EN 13658-2 and metal beads and feature profiles covered by the harmonised standard EN 14353, with regard to their reaction to fire
- Intention not to raise objections to a delegated act

1. The Commission has submitted the above delegated act¹ to the Council in accordance with the procedure set out in Article 290 TFEU and Article 60 of Regulation (EU) No 305/2011 laying down harmonised conditions for the marketing of construction products and repealing Council Directive 89/106/EEC. The delegated act is based on Article 27 (5) of that Regulation. The Commission having notified the delegated act to the Council on 17 July 2014, the Council has until **17 October 2014** to object to it.
2. The Working Party on Technical Harmonisation has examined the delegated act both by written procedure and at a Working Party meeting on 19 September 2014. It has concluded that there are no grounds for the Council to object to it.

3. It is therefore suggested that the Permanent Representatives Committee recommend that the Council confirm that it has no intention to object the delegated act and that the Commission and the European Parliament are to be informed thereof. This implies, that unless the European Parliament objects to it, the delegated act shall be published and enter into force in accordance with Article 60 of Regulation (EU) No 305/2011.
