<u>The Committee</u> considered the question of the possible submission of observations to the International Tribunal for the Law of the Sea (ITLOS) on the request for an Advisory Opinion from the Sub-regional Fisheries Commission (SRFC). <u>Delegations and the Presidency</u> insisted that it is for the Council, in accordance with its policy-making functions under Article 16 TEU, to decide whether the Union should submit observations and, if so, to endorse their content. They disagreed with the <u>Commission</u> that Article 335 TFEU would allow the Commission to submit observations to the Tribunal on behalf of the Union without such prior endorsement by the Council.

<u>The Committee</u> noted that, insofar as the Council could not endorse any position regarding a possible submission to ITLOS on behalf of the European Union,

- no European Union position existed in this regards; and, therefore,
- no observations could be submitted to ITLOS on behalf of the European Union on the request for an Advisory Opinion from SRFC.
