Subject: COMMISSION REGULATION (EU) No .../. of XXX amending Regulation (EU) No 142/2011 implementing Regulation (EC) No 1069/2009 of the European Parliament and of the Council laying down health rules as regards animal by-products and derived products not intended for human consumption and implementing Council Directive 97/78/EC as regards certain samples and items exempt from veterinary checks at the border under that Directive

- Decision not to oppose the adoption (regulatory procedure with scrutiny)

1. On 12 September 2014, following the positive opinion of the Commission's Standing Committee on the Food Chain and Animal Health (on 3 July 2014), the Commission submitted for scrutiny by the Council and the European Parliament a draft Commission Regulation (EU) No .../. of XXX amending Regulation (EU) No 142/2011 implementing Regulation (EC) No 1069/2009 of the European Parliament and of the Council laying down health rules as regards animal by-products and derived products not intended for human consumption and implementing Council Directive 97/78/EC as regards certain samples and items exempt from veterinary checks at the border under that Directive.
2. The Working Group of Agricultural Counsellors/Attachés considered through an informal written procedure that there are no grounds for the Council to oppose the adoption of the draft Commission Regulation.

3. The Permanent Representatives Committee is therefore invited:
