- Notification regarding the recommendation 10.1.1.

Dear Sir / Madam,

Within the framework of the Sixth Round of Mutual Evaluations of the GENVAL Council Working Party, the following recommendation was made to Germany:

"10.1.1. Germany should inform the General Secretariat of the Council of the specific person from the Federal Office of Justice responsible for the functioning of the ENCS; (cf. 3.2.2 and 3.5.4)." The background of this recommendation is the fact that the Federal Republic of Germany has enshrined into law the responsibility for the functioning of the ENCS. Under section 4 (2) of the

Ordinance on Coordination of Cooperation with Eurojust, the Federal Office of Justice is responsible for organisation of the Eurojust Coordination System. The recommendation requests the Federal Republic of Germany - in addition to the legal implementation of which the Council Secretariat and Eurojust were already informed (see Council Document 16375/12, p.4) - to inform the Council Secretariat of the person from the Federal Office of Justice specifically entrusted with this task. 2
