Subject: Special Report No 15/2014 "The External Borders Fund has fostered financial solidarity but requires better measurement of results and needs to provide further EU added value"  
- *Designation of Working Party*

1. On 10 October 2014, the General Secretariat of the Council received the European Court of Auditors' Special Report No 15/2014 entitled "The External Border Fund has fostered financial solidarity but requires better measurement of results and needs to provide further EU added value"<sup>1</sup>.
2.
