Subject: Draft COUNCIL DECISION appointing the members and alternate members of the Advisory Committee on Freedom of Movement for Workers for Cyprus, Hungary and Portugal

1. The term of office of the members and alternate members of the Advisory Committee on Freedom of Movement for Workers will expire on 24 September 2014.
2. Having regard to Regulation (EU) No 492/2011 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 5 April 2011 on freedom of movement for workers within the Union¹, and in particular Articles 23 and 24 thereof, members and alternate members are appointed by the Council for a period of two years.
3. Lists of nominations of full and alternate members of the renewed Advisory Committee have been received by the Council Secretariat, as set out in the draft Council Decision in doc. 14382².
