- 1. By application notified to the Council on 17 October 2014, the Applicant brought an action pursuant to Articles 263, 264 and 275 TFEU to annul Council Decision 2011/137/CFSP concerning restrictive measures in view of the situation in Libya, as amended by Council Decision 2014/380/CFSP of 23 June 2014, and Council Regulation (EU) no 204/2011 of 2 March 2011, as implemented by Council Implementing Regulation (EU) no 689/2014 of 23 June 2014 implementing article 16(2) of Regulation (EU) no 204/2011 concerning restrictive measures in view of the situation in Libya, insofar as they apply to the Applicant;
- 2. The applicant invokes the following grounds in support of her claim for annulment of the contested Legal acts:
 - a) lack of legal basis;
 - b) violation of the Applicant's rights of the defence and the right to effective judicial protection;
 - violation of the Applicant's right to respect for property, the right to family
 life and the principle of proportionality;
 - d) the unlawfulness of the contested measures.
