Migration flows:

The Chair recalled the adoption of the Council conclusions "Taking action to better manage migratory flows" and formally invited the Commission, in close cooperation with the EEAS, to report, through an ad hoc scorecard, on the state of play of the implementation of its operational actions to the December JHA Council.

Foreign Fighters:

The Chair referred to document 14160/14 which sets out the results of the Council's debate on foreign fighters and stressed that the Presidency wished to keep this subject high on the agenda. To that end, a roadmap (DS 1461/14) had been developed, which the CTC briefly presented as a living document that would be adapted to take on board comments and developments. The Commission announced they would send clarifications and explained that some of the commitments should be reviewed to be more realistic and/or discussed by the new Commissioners.

The Committee took note of the proceedings of this Council meeting.

Regarding the DAC directive FR asked AT when they would start exchanging information on tax issues. AT replied that this had not been determined yet.
