## **INFORMATION NOTE**

Subject: Case before the General Court of the EU

-Case T-715/14 (NK Rosneft OAO and Others v. Council of the EU)

- 1. By an application notified to the Council on 9 October 2014, Applicant has brought an action pursuant to Articles 263, 264 and 275 TFEU for the annulment of certain provisions of Council Decision 2014/512/CFSP of 31 July 2014 concerning restrictive measures in view of Russia's actions destabilising the situation in Ukraine and of Council Regulation (EU) No 833/2014 of 31 July 2014 concerning restrictive measures in view of Russia's actions destabilising the situation in Ukraine, as amended, respectively by Council Decision 2014/659/CFSP of 8 September 2014 and Council Regulation (EU) No 960/2014 of 8 September 2014.
- 2 The applicant submits the following grounds of annulment in his application:
  - failure to provide reasons sufficient to permit review of legality, breach of defence rights/effective judicial protection,
  - absence of legitimate and/or lawful aim,
  - breach of the Union's international obligations under the Partnership and Cooperation
     Agreement with the Russian Federation and/or under the GATT,

- absence of rational connection between the aim and the means for giving effect to it,
- authorisation provisions do not give proper effect to the Decision,
- reach of the principle of equal treatment and non arbitrariness,
- disproportionate measures, and consequential encroachment of Union legislative competences, and breach of the Applicants' fundamental rights,
- misuse of powers,
- breach of constitutional guarantees of legal certainty.
- 2. The applicant has made an application for an expedited procedure.
- 3. In accordance with Article 76a of the General Court's Rules of Procedure, in the case of an expedited procedure, the Council has to lodge a statement of defence within one month of the date on which the application was notified to it.
- 4. The Director-General of the Legal Service of the Council has appointed Ms. Sonja BOELAERT and Mr. Bart DRIESSEN, legal advisors in the said service, as the Council's agents in this case.
