Subject: COMMISSION DELEGATED REGULATION (EU) No .../.. of 8.10.2014 supplementing Directive 2013/36/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council with regard to regulatory technical standards for the specification of the methodology for the identification of global systemically important institutions and for the definition of subcategories of global systemically important institutions  
- Intention not to raise objections to a delegated act

---

1. The Commission submitted the above delegated act to the Council in accordance with the procedure set out in Article 290 TFEU and with Article 131(8) of Directive No 36/2013/EU<sup>1</sup>.  
The deadline for raising objections to this delegated act is 8 November 2014.
2. No objections were raised by delegations during the silence procedure expired on 31 October 2014.

It is therefore suggested that Coreper recommend that the Council confirm that it has no intention to object to the delegated act and that the Commission and the European Parliament are to be informed thereof. This implies that, unless the European Parliament objects to it, the delegated act shall be published and enter into force in accordance with Article 131(8) of Directive No 36/2013/EU.
