Subject:	Proposal for transfer of appropriations No DEC 47/2014 within Section III - Commission - of the general budget for 2014

1. On 4 November 2014, the Commission submitted to the Council proposal for transfer of appropriations No DEC 47/2014.

The purpose of this proposal is to transfer an amount of EUR 17 million in commitment and payment appropriations from Article 40 02 42 (*Emergency aid reserve*) to Article 23 02 01 (*Delivery of rapid, effective and needs-based humanitarian aid and food assistance*), as recorded in document 15030/14 FIN 814.

2. The transfer is being proposed in order to provide humanitarian assistance to respond to the increased needs in the crisis originated by the Ebola outbreak in West Africa, for an amount of EUR 17 million.
3. The Budget Committee examined this proposal for a transfer at its meeting on 10 November 2014.

4. Following that examination, the Budget Committee agreed, by a qualified majority, to suggest that the Permanent Representatives Committee advise the Council to approve:
- the proposed transfer of appropriations;
 - the draft letter in the ANNEX to that effect.
