Subject: Case before the Court of Justice:
- Case C-455/14 P (H v. Council and Commission of the European Union)

1. By application notified to the Council on 24 October 2014, H an Italian judge who was seconded to the EU Police Mission in Bosnia Herzegovina (EUPM) is seeking to set aside the order of the General Court of 10 July 2014 in Case T-271/10 (*H against Council, Commission and "EUPM"*), insofar as it rejects the applicant's action seeking the annulment of the Decision of the 7 April 2010, signed by the Chief of the personnel of the EUPM, by which the applicant was redeployed to the post of "criminal Justice Adviser-Prosecutor" in the regional office of Banja Luka and, if needed, of the Decision of 30 April 2010, signed by the head of Mission referred to in Article 6 of the Council decision 2009/906/CFSP of 8 December 2009 on the EUPM (OL 2009 L 322, P.22) and to ask the defendant at the first instance to pay the costs of these proceedings and also for the damages.

2. H invokes the following pleas in law in support of its application:
 - infringement of the rights of the defence,
 - Infringement of article 114 of the rules of procedure of the General Court,
 - error in law-Infringement of European Law,
3. The Director-General of the Council Legal Service has appointed Mr Alessandro VITRO and Mr Frederik NAERT, legal advisors in the Council Legal Service, as the Council's agents in this case.
