Subject: COMMISSION DELEGATED REGULATION (EU) No .../. of 15.10.2014
supplementing Regulation (EU) No 167/2013 of the European Parliament
and of the Council with regard to vehicle braking requirements for the
approval of agricultural and forestry vehicles
- Intention not to raise objections to a delegated act

1. The Commission has submitted the above delegated act to the Council in accordance with the procedure set out in Article 290(2)(b) TFEU and with regard to Article 17(5) of Regulation (EU) No 167/2013 on the approval and market surveillance of agricultural and forestry vehicles¹. The Commission having adopted the delegated act on 15 October 2014, the Council may object to it until 15 December 2014.
2. The Working Party on Technical Harmonisation (Motor Vehicles) has examined the delegated act by an electronic information procedure initiated on 17 October 2014 and silently agreed by that there are no grounds for the Council to object to it.

3. It is therefore suggested that the Permanent Representatives Committee recommends to the Council to confirm that it has no intention to object to the delegated act and that the Commission and the European Parliament are to be informed thereof. This implies, that unless the European Parliament objects to it, the delegated act shall be published and enter into force on the twentieth day following that of its publication in the Official Journal of the European Union in accordance with Article 19 of the Delegated Regulation.
