## I. INTRODUCTION

On 21 August 2014, the European Commission transmitted to the Council a
 Communication on the EU Strategy and Action Plan for customs risk management:
 Tackling risks, strengthening supply chain security and facilitating trade<sup>1</sup>. This
 Communication was presented to the Customs Union Working Party at its meeting
 on 23 September 2014.

- 2. Following this presentation, the Presidency prepared draft Council Conclusions on the EU Strategy and Action Plan on customs risk management: Tackling risks, strengthening supply chain security and facilitating trade, which were transmitted to delegations on 24 October 2014.<sup>2</sup>.
- 3. At its meetings on 29 October and 5 November 2014, the Customs Union Working

  Party examined the above draft Conclusions and reached an understanding on the text set out in doc. 15403/14, including a preliminary agreement on the following issues:
  - a reference to the conclusions of the cost-benefit study commissioned to support the implementation of the Strategy and to enhance effective customs risk management in the EU should be introduced under "RECALLING";
  - the concept of supervision should be added to the one of control in relation to the risks management Strategy;
  - the roadmap for the implementation of the Strategy and the Action Plan should be realistic and detailed;
  - the Commission should report to the Council within a 18 months time frame on the implementation of the Strategy and the Action Plan and on the results achieved.
- 4. <u>The Permanent Representatives Committee</u>, at its meeting on 19-21 November 2014, endorsed the agreement reached by the Working Party.
