| Subject:        | Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) No .../.. of 24.10.2014 laying down standards regarding candidate volunteers and EU Aid Volunteers<br>- Intention not to raise objection to a delegated act |

1. The Commission has submitted the above delegated act<sup>1</sup> to the Council in accordance with the procedure set out in Article 290 TFEU and with Article 24 of Regulation (EU) No 375/2014 establishing the European Voluntary Humanitarian Aid Corps ('EU Aid Volunteers initiative')<sup>2</sup>. The Commission having notified the delegated act on 24 October 2014, the Council may object to it until 23 December 2014.
2. The Working Party on Humanitarian Aid and Food Aid has examined the delegated act and agreed that there are no grounds for the Council to object to it.

3. It is therefore suggested that Coreper recommend that the Council confirm that it has no intention to object to the delegated act and that the Commission and the European Parliament are to be informed thereof. This implies that, unless the European Parliament objects to it, the delegated act shall be published and enter into force on the third day following the publication of the decision in the Official Journal of the European Union in accordance with Article 24(3) of Regulation (EU) No 375/2014 and Article 19 of the draft Delegated Regulation.
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
