Subject:	Proposal for a COUNCIL DECISION concerning the dock dues in the French outermost regions
	- adoption of the legislative act

- 1. The Commission submitted the above-mentioned proposal to the Council on 29 October 2014.
- 2. On 6 November 2014, the Working Party on Outermost Regions examined the proposal. Following a silence procedure, on 17 November 2014, consensus was reached on a revised text, which added a new recital for introducing an exception to the requirement of an eightweek consultation period of the national parliaments, laid down by Article 4 of Protocol No 1 of the Treaty. Such an exception was needed due to the urgency for adopting the legislative measure which should guarantee the legal framework for the dock dues from 1 January 2015.
- 3. On 3 December 2014, the European Parliament's Committee on Regional Development (hereinafter "REGI Committee") approved its report on the Commission proposal for the Council decision without suggesting any amendments.

- 4. Consequently, on 16 December 2014, the European Parliament is expected to adopt its opinion on the proposal, based on REGI Committee's report, without suggesting any amendments.
- 5. Provided that the European Parliament adopts its opinion on 16 December 2014 as described above, it is suggested that the Permanent Representatives Committee invite the Council to:
  - adopt as an "A" item the above-mentioned proposal, as finalised by the Lawyer Linguists and as set out in document 15406/14, and after having regard to the opinion of the European Parliament.
