Subject: Draft Council Conclusions on Electronic Customs and Single Window Implementation in the European Union  
- Adoption

---

1. At its meetings on 13 and 24 November 2014, the Working Party on Customs Union (Customs Legislation and Policy) examined the above draft Conclusions, the aim of which is:
  - to endorse the Venice Declaration, as attached to the draft, and to call on the Member States and the Commission to implement it;
  - to agree by 2015 on an action plan and a roadmap to enable the implementation of a Single Window environment for Customs, and
  - to invite the Commission to present a proposal in view of the revision of the e-Customs Decision,and agreed of the text laid down in doc. 16507/14 UD 275.
  
2. Against this background, the Permanent Representatives Committee could:
  - confirm the agreement reached within the Working Party; and
  - invite the Council to adopt the Council Conclusions, as set out in doc. 16507/14 UD 275, as an item without discussion at one of its forthcoming meetings.
