Subject:	Council Decision on the conclusion, on behalf of the European Union, of the Agreement between the European Union and the Republic of the Seychelles on access for fishing vessels flying the flag of the Seychelles to waters and marine biological resources of Mayotte, under the jurisdiction of the European Union
	- adoption

- 1. The <u>European Commission</u> adopted on 10 March 2014 a proposal for the above Council Decision.
- 2. The proposed Agreement on access by Seychelles-flagged fishing vessels to EU waters off the coast of Mayotte follows on the status change of Mayotte which became an outermost region of the EU on 1 January 2014.
- 3. The Working Party on Internal and External Fisheries Policy examined the proposal on 18 March 2014. The French delegation recalled that as for other Decisions to conclude an agreement or protocol, the legal basis should make reference to Article 43 TFEU in its entirety rather than to Article 43(2). The Commission representative announced that the Commission would make a statement regarding the change of the legal basis. The Presidency noted the delegations' support for the proposal with an amended legal basis.

- 4. On 14 April 2014 the Council unanimously decided to change the legal basis to "Article 43 in conjunction with 218(6)(a) and Article 218(7) TFEU ". The Council also decided to sign and provisionally apply the Agreement. The signing took place on 20 May 2014.
- 5. The European Parliament gave its consent on 13 January 2015.
- 6. The Permanent Representative Committee is invited to suggest that Council, at one of its forth-coming sessions:
 - adopts with unanimity the Decision on the conclusion of the Agreement as set out in a) doc. ST 7911/14 PECHE 147 (as finalised by the legal-linguistic experts);
 - enters in its minutes the statements contained in the addendum to this note. b)
