As Chair of the Working Party on cooperation in Criminal Matters, I am pleased to invite representatives of Eurojust to attend the meeting of COPEN (Eurojust Regulation) scheduled for 27th January to discuss Article 59 of the draft Regulation on Confidentiality. As Eurojust has previously raised concerns about the practical impact of this provision in its current form, I thought it would be useful for Eurojust to explain its concerns directly to delegates to allow them to prepare a text which is legally acceptable and workable in practice.
