Subject: - Proposal for a Decision of the European Parliament and of the Council on the mobilisation of the European Globalisation Adjustment Fund (application EGF/2014/016 IE/Lufthansa Technik)

- Proposal for transfer of appropriations No DEC 10/2015 within Section III - Commission - of the general budget for 2015

---

1. The Commission submitted to the Council a proposal for a Decision of the European Parliament and of the Council on the mobilisation of the European Globalisation Adjustment Fund (EGF), as recorded in document 6121/15 FIN 112 SOC 64, accompanied by the corresponding proposal for transfer of appropriations No DEC 10/2015, as recorded in document 6123/15 FIN 113.

2. The proposal aims at mobilising an amount of EUR 2 490 758 under the EGF to meet an application from Ireland to deploy the Fund in connection with 424 redundancies in three enterprises operating in the repair and installation of machinery and equipment sector. The redundancies are the result of major structural changes in world trade patterns due to globalisation.

The purpose of the proposed transfer is to move an amount of EUR 2 490 758 in commitment appropriations from Article 40 02 43 (*Reserve for the European Globalisation Adjustment Fund*) to Article 04 04 01 (*EGF- to support workers and self-employed persons whose activity has ceased as a result of the globalisation*).

3. The Budget Committee examined both proposals at its meeting on 19 February 2015.
4. Following that examination, the Budget Committee agreed, by a qualified majority, to suggest that the Permanent Representatives Committee advise the Council to:
- adopt the draft Decision on the mobilisation of the EGF as set out in ANNEX 1;
  - approve the proposed transfer of appropriations;
  - approve the draft letter in ANNEX 2 to that effect.

**DRAFT DECISION OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL**

**on the mobilisation of the European Globalisation Adjustment Fund (application EGF/2014/016 IE/Lufthansa Technik from Ireland)**

THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN UNION,

Having regard to the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union,

Having regard to Regulation (EU) No 1309/2013 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 17 December 2013 on the European Globalisation Adjustment Fund (2014-2020) and repealing Regulation (EC) No 1927/2006<sup>1</sup>, and in particular Article 15(4) thereof,

Having regard to the Interinstitutional Agreement of 2 December 2013 between the European Parliament, the Council and the Commission on budgetary discipline, on cooperation in budgetary matters and on sound financial management<sup>2</sup>, and in particular point 13 thereof,

Having regard to the proposal from the European Commission,

Whereas:

- (1) The European Globalisation Adjustment Fund (EGF) was established to provide support for workers made redundant and self-employed persons whose activity has ceased as a result of major structural changes in world trade patterns due to globalisation, as a result of a continuation of the global financial and economic crisis addressed in Regulation (EC) No 546/2009<sup>3</sup>, or as a result of a new global financial and economic crisis and to assist them with their reintegration into the labour market.

- (2) Article 12 of Council Regulation (EU, Euratom) No 1311/2013<sup>1</sup> allows the mobilisation of the EGF within a maximum annual amount of EUR 150 million (2011 prices).
- (3) Ireland submitted an application to mobilise the EGF, in respect of redundancies in Lufthansa Technik Airmotive Ireland Ltd. and two suppliers in Ireland, on 19 September 2014 and supplemented it by additional information as provided by Article 8(3) of Regulation (EU) No 1309/2013. This application complies with the requirements for determining a financial contribution from the EGF as laid down in Article 13 of Regulation (EU) No 1309/2013.
- (4) The EGF should, therefore, be mobilised in order to provide a financial contribution of an amount of EUR 2 490 758 for the application submitted by Ireland,

HAVE ADOPTED THIS DECISION:

*Article 1*

For the general budget of the European Union for the financial year 2015, the European Globalisation Adjustment Fund shall be mobilised to provide the sum of EUR 2 490 758 in commitment and payment appropriations.

*Article 2*

This decision shall be published in the *Official Journal of the European Union*.
