Subject: COMMISSION REGULATION (EU) .../... of XXX defining acceptability criteria for detoxification processes applied to products intended for animal feed as provided for in Directive 2002/32/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council

- Decision not to oppose the adoption (regulatory procedure with scrutiny)

1. On 23 January 2015, following the positive opinion of the Commission's Standing Committee on Plants, Animals, Food and Feed (on 17 December 2014), the Commission submitted for scrutiny by the Council and the European Parliament a draft Commission Regulation (EU) .../... of XXX defining acceptability criteria for detoxification processes applied to products intended for animal feed as provided for in Directive 2002/32/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council.
2. The Working Group of Agricultural Counsellors/Attachés considered through an informal written procedure that there are no grounds for the Council to oppose the adoption of the draft Commission Regulation.
