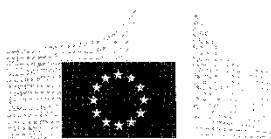

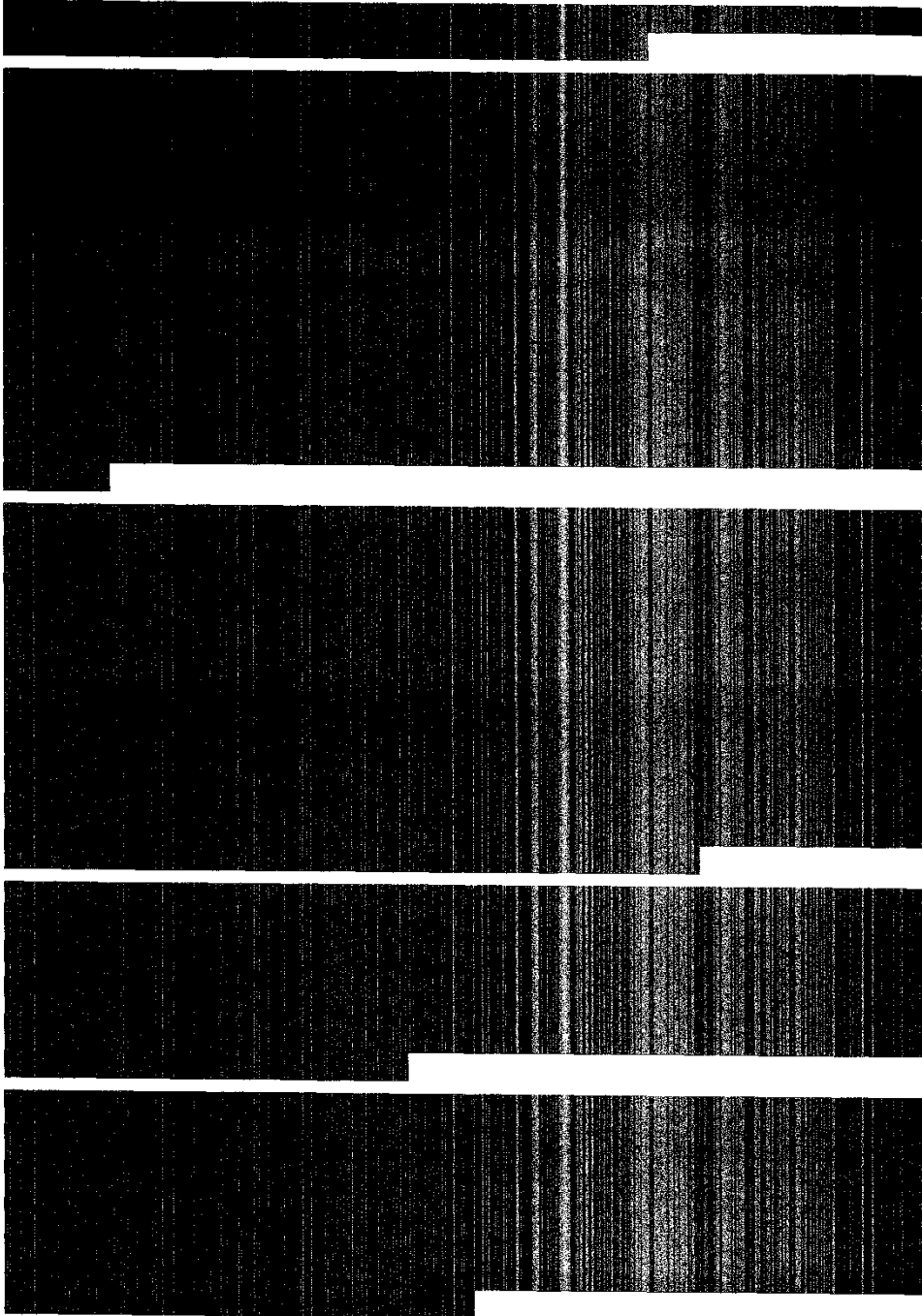

COUNCIL DECISION

authorising the Commission to open negotiations on an agreement between the European Union and the Republic of Tunisia on readmission

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN UNION,

Having regard to the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union, and in particular Article 218(3) and (4) thereof,

Having regard to the recommendation from the European Commission,

Whereas negotiations should be opened with a view to concluding an agreement with Tunisia on Readmission

HAS ADOPTED THIS DECISION:

Article 1

The Commission is hereby authorised to negotiate, on behalf of the Union, an international agreement on readmission between the European Union and Tunisia.

Article 2

The negotiating directives are set out in the Annex.

Article 3

The negotiations shall be conducted in consultation with the Working Party on Integration, Migration and Expulsion.

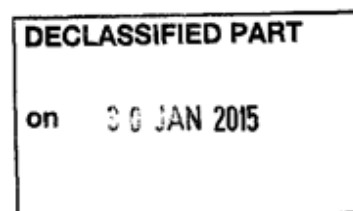
