**STATEMENT BY THE UNITED KINGDOM**

Article 1(3) of the proposed Regulation introduces a new Article 7(6) into Commission Regulation 865/2006, stating that “*Export permits and re-export certificates issued by third countries shall be accepted only if the competent authority from the third country concerned provides, where requested to do so, satisfactory information that the specimens were obtained in accordance with the legislation on the protection of the species concerned*”. The UK considers that the CITES Management Authorities of Member States retain the discretion to decide when it is appropriate to seek information from the CITES Management Authority of the third country concerned.
