Subject:	Action Plan on Cooperation in the Customs Enforcement of Intellectual Property Rights in the European Union and Hong Kong, China - Approval

1. On 23 March 2015, the Commission transmitted to the Council the above Action Plan, of a non-binding nature, and aiming at tackling international trade in goods infringing intellectual property rights throughout the supply chain.
2. On 25 March 2015, the Working Party on Customs Union examined the text of the Action Plan and agreed on an amended version of the text, as laid down in doc. 7382/1/15 REV 1.
7. In view of the above, the Permanent Representatives Committee could therefore invite the Council to approve the Action Plan as set out in doc. 7382/1/15 REV 1 as an item without discussion.
