Subject: Special Report No 3/2015 "EU Youth Guarantee: first steps taken but implementation risks ahead"  
- *Designation of Working Party*

1. On 27 March 2015, the General Secretariat of the Council received the European Court of Auditors' Special Report No 3/2015 entitled "EU Youth Guarantee: first steps taken but implementation risks ahead"<sup>1</sup>.
