Subject: CORRIGENDUM to Commission Delegated Regulation of 18 December 2014 supplementing Directive 2010/40/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council with regard to the provision of EU-wide real-time traffic information services (C(2014)9672)
– Intention not to raise objections to a delegated act

1. On 17 April 2015, the Council received a CORRIGENDUM to the Commission Delegated Regulation supplementing Directive 2010/40/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council with regard to the provision of EU-wide real-time traffic information services (doc. 17094/14 COR1).
2. The draft measure was already examined by the Council and by the European Parliament. This CORRIGENDUM revisits only the inappropriate use of the word "namely" as regards several categories of data. Since this change affects several linguistic versions of the delegated act, a new period for reactions from Council and Parliament was launched by the Commission.

3. Delegations were asked to submit any comments on this file by 8 May 2015. Delegations have not provided any indication that there is any reason to oppose the CORRIGENDUM to the draft measure in question on the grounds described in Decision 1999/468, namely that it:
- exceeds the implementing powers provided for in the basic instrument;
 - is incompatible with the aim or content of the basic instrument; or
 - does not respect the principles of subsidiarity or proportionality.
4. Following the above, COREPER is invited to approve this CORRIGENDUM and submit it to Council as an "A" item allowing the Commission to adopt the above draft Regulation as corrected.
