	- Request to extend the period for objections to a delegated act

1. The <u>Commission</u> has submitted the above delegated act<sup>1</sup> to the Council in accordance with the procedure set out in Article 290 TFEU and Article 60 of Regulation (EU) No 305/2011 laying down harmonised conditions for the marketing of construction products and repealing Council Directive 89/106/EEC. The delegated act is based on Article 7 (3) of that Regulation. The Commission having notified the delegated act to the Council on 30 October 2013, the Council has until **30 January 2014** to object to it.

- 2. The <u>Working Party on Technical Harmonisation</u> has examined the delegated act by written procedure and also at a meeting on 11 December 2013. It has agreed by simple majority to require an extension of the period for possible objections to **30 April 2014**.
- 3. It is therefore suggested that the <u>Permanent Representatives Committee</u> recommends to the Council to decide in favour of an extension of the period for raising objections by three months and that the Commission and the European Parliament are to be informed thereof.
