Subject: Advisory Committee on Freedom of Movement for Workers

1. The General Secretariat of the Council has been informed of the resignation of Ms Agnė PECIUKEVIČIENĒ as member of the above Committee in the government representatives category (for Lithuania).
2. Under Article 24 of Regulation (EU) No 492/2011 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 5 April 2011 on freedom of movement for workers within the Union, members and alternate members are appointed by the Council.

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN UNION,

Having regard to Regulation (EU) No 492/2011 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 5 April 2011 on freedom of movement for workers within the Union¹, and in particular Articles 23 and 24 thereof.

Whereas:

- (1) In its Decision of 25 September 2014², the Council appointed the members and alternate members of the Advisory Committee on Freedom of Movement for Workers for the period ending on 24 September 2016.
- (2) A seat as member in the government representatives category has fallen vacant as a result of the resignation of Ms Agnė PECIUKEVIČIENĖ.
- (3) The Government of Lithuania has submitted a nomination for the vacant seat,
