Subject: Proposal for a REGULATION OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL amending Regulation (EU) No 1236/2010 of the European Parliament and of the Council laying down a scheme of control and enforcement applicable in the area covered by the Convention on future multilateral cooperation in the North-East Atlantic fisheries

- Endorsement of the mandate for the informal trilogue

1. On 12 March 2015, the Commission submitted to the Council a Proposal for a REGULATION OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL amending Regulation (EU) No 1236/2010 of the European Parliament and of the Council laying down a scheme of control and enforcement applicable in the area covered by the Convention on future multilateral cooperation in the North-East Atlantic fisheries. Its purpose is to incorporate obligations resulting from the North-East Atlantic Fisheries Commission's Recommendations 15/2013, 9/2014 and 12/2015 into Union law. These recommendations were adopted with full EU support.
2. During the following months, the Working Party on Internal and External Fisheries Policy examined the proposal, taking into account comments made by two delegations¹, and reached a tentative negotiating position, in full agreement with the Commission's proposal.

3. In preparation of the upcoming informal trilogues, COREPER is invited to endorse this tentative negotiating position reached at the technical level.
