#### 1. INTRODUCTION

1. The Commission transmitted the above-mentioned proposal on 27 March 2014.<sup>1</sup>
2. The Council Working Party on Technical Harmonisation has examined the package at six WP meetings since June 2014.

3. The Council agreed on a General Approach concerning this file on 4 December 2014<sup>2</sup>. At this occasion, the Presidency was also mandated to enter into informal contacts with the representatives of the European Parliament and the European Commission in order to explore the possibility of an agreement at first reading.
4. The IMCO Committee of the European Parliament adopted its report at first reading on 17 March 2015.

## II. STATE OF PLAY

5. During several technical meetings and at the occasion of the first trilogue on 11 May 2015 it was possible to reach agreement between the institutions on most of the text. At a further technical meeting on 5 June the few open issues were further reduced to those of horizontal nature<sup>3</sup>(to be discussed at a trilogue on 16 June together with the Regulations on Personal Protective Equipment and on Appliances burning gaseous fuels) and very few minor linguistic or technical items. The Presidency therefore considers that the substance of the General Approach as adopted in December 2014 is maintained

## III. CONCLUSION

6. The Committee is invited to mandate the Presidency to finalise the agreement on the basis of the General Approach and to endorse the few technical amendments already being included in the text.

For the information of the Committee the latest version of the four-column-document concerning the Regulation on Cableway Installations is set out in doc. 9607/15 ADD 1.
