1. On 8 March 2011, the Commission sent the above proposal <sup>1</sup>, based on Article 207 of the TFEU to the Council.

- 2. At its 3257th meeting on 23 September 2013, the <u>Council</u> (Agriculture and Fisheries) confirmed the political agreement on the Council's position at first reading on the above Regulation. The Annex to the "I/A" note 1 contained a number of statements to be entered into the minutes of the Council when adopting its position at first reading and to be published in the Official Journal.
- 3. The <u>Council</u> (Economic and Financial Affairs) at its 3271st meeting on 15 November 2013 adopted its position at first reading as set out in 13283/13 and the statement of reasons set out in 13283/13 ADD 1. Due to a material error, the "I/A" note did not contain an Addendum with the statements, which consequently were not recorded at the above mentioned meeting.
- 4. Consequently, the Permanent Representatives Committee is invited to suggest that the Council, at a forthcoming meeting:
  - agree to enter into the minutes of the Council the statements set out in the Annex to this note, and
  - decide to publish them in the Official Journal together with the adopted text of the Regulation.
