ERAC will discuss and agree on the plans to iterate the proposal in order that ERAC may give a timely input to the Presidency for its preparations for December Competiveness Council.

6. ERA and Innovation Policy

6.1 The EU ERA Roadmap and the national ERA Roadmaps

In follow-up to the Council conclusions on the ERA Roadmap, there will be a break-out session for informal discussions between Member States on taking the Roadmap forward at national level.

The Working Group on Monitoring will update ERAC on the progress towards a set of indicators for monitoring the ERA Roadmap (Annex 4) and the timeline for ERAC to present its proposal by the end of 2015.

7. Investment Plan for Europe: implementation / consequences of political decisions on R&I projects

There will be presentation from a representative of the EIB on the implementation of the European Fund for Strategic Investment and in particular the assessment of projects.

Some of the showcase R&I projects submitted by Member States will be used as concrete examples to facilitate the discussion relating to the processes that have been set-up.
