Given more immediate payment needs on some completion lines in the Development Cooperation Instrument, an amount of EUR 10 million in payment appropriations can be made available from this budget line, without a negative impact on evaluation activities and without giving rise to payment of late interest.

# d) Detailed grounds for the transfer

On 3 July 2015, the implementation of the payment appropriations on this budget line has reached 95%. Out of the EUR 140 million of appropriations voted on that line, EUR 45 million have been used to pay the backlog of invoices transferred from 2014 to 2015.

It is estimated that, unless reinforced, the appropriations on this budget line will run out in July. Therefore, a reinforcement of EUR 9.5 million is requested to cover some important pending payments, among which a payment to the Livelihood and Food Security Trust Fund and several payments under projects in Africa.

On 3 July 2015, the implementation of the payment appropriations on this budget line has reached 86%. Out of the EUR 138 million of appropriations voted on that line, EUR 16 million have been used to pay the backlog of invoices transferred from 2014 to 2015.

It is estimated that, unless reinforced, the appropriations on this budget line will run out in August. Therefore, a reinforcement of EUR 3 million is requested to cover some important pending payments, among which a payment under a project for empowering Civil Society Organisations Networks.

# d) Detailed grounds for the transfer

On 3 July 2015, the implementation of the payment appropriations on this budget line has reached 78%. Out of the EUR 84 million of appropriations voted on that line, EUR 16 million have been used to pay the backlog of invoices transferred from 2014 to 2015.

It is estimated that, unless reinforced, the appropriations on this budget line will run out in August. Therefore, a reinforcement of EUR 3 million is requested to cover some important pending payments, among which a payment under the Low Emission Capacity Building programme, a payment under the SWITCH Africa Green programme, a payment to the Critical Ecosystem Partnership Fund and payment under the "Capacity building for carbon dioxide mitigation from international aviation" programme.
