Subject: COMMISSION DELEGATED REGULATION (EU) .../... of 8.7.2015
supplementing Regulation (EU) 514/2014 of the European Parliament and
of the Council with specific provisions on the reporting of irregularities
concerning the Asylum, Migration and Integration Fund and the instrument
for financial support for police cooperation, preventing and combating
crime, and crisis management
- Intention not to raise objection to a delegated act

1. The Commission submitted the above delegated act¹ to the Council in accordance with the procedure set out in Article 290 TFEU and Regulation (EU) No 514/2014 of the European Parliament and of the Council laying down general provisions on the Asylum, Migration and Integration Fund and on the instrument for financial support for police cooperation, preventing and combating crime, and crisis management², and in particular its Article 5(5) thereof. The Commission having notified the delegated act on 8 July 2015, the Council may object to it until 8 September 2015.

2. The Justice and Home Affairs Counsellors were consulted and no delegation considered that there would be grounds for the Council to object to it.
 3. It is therefore suggested that Coreper recommend that the Council confirm that it has no intention to object to the above mentioned delegated act and that the Commission and the European Parliament are to be informed thereof. This implies that, unless the European Parliament objects to it, the delegated act shall be published and enter into force in accordance with Article 58 of Regulation (EU) No 514/2014.
