DIRECTIVES FOR THE NEGOTIATION OF AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE EUROPEAN UNION AND THE REPUBLIC OF AZERBAIJAN ON A LEGAL FRAMEWORK GOVERNING THE CONTROL OF DESFA BY SOCAR.

The Agreement should ensure:

That the control by SOCAR and the Republic of Azerbaijan, over DESFA will not put at risk the security of energy supplies to the European Union by:

- (1) ensuring that EU and Greek law applicable to DESFA as well as any possible future modifications thereof, apply in full; and,
- (2) are fully enforceable on DESFA, SOCAR and the Republic of Azerbaijan.

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
