Subject: Commission Delegated Regulation supplementing Regulation (EU) 2015/1017 of the European Parliament and Council by the establishment of a scoreboard of indicators for the application of the EU guarantee.
- Intention not to raise objections to a delegated act

1. The Commission has submitted the above delegated act¹ to the Council in accordance with the procedure set out in Article 290 TFEU and with Article 7(14) of Regulation (EU) 2015/1017². The Commission having notified the delegated act with regard to the establishment of a scoreboard of indicators for the application of the EU guarantee on 21 August 2015, the Council may object to it until 11 September 2015.

2. The Financial Counsellors Working Party members during the informal written consultations between 21 and 27 August 2015 did not raise any grounds for the Council to object to it.
 3. It is therefore suggested that Coreper recommend that the Council confirm that it has no intention to object to the delegated act and that the Commission and the European Parliament are to be informed thereof.
 4. It is therefore suggested that the Permanent Representatives Committee
 - agrees to use of the written procedure for the adoption of the decision on non objection, and recommend to the Council to:
 - confirm that it has no intention to object to the delegated regulation and
 - agree to inform accordingly the European Parliament and the Commission.
 5. This implies that, unless the European Parliament objects to it, the delegated act shall be published and with Article 23(5) of Regulation (EU) 2015/1017.
