Subject:	Proposal for transfer of appropriations No DEC 26/2015 within Section III - Commission - of the general budget for 2015		

1. On 8 September 2015, the Commission submitted to the Council proposal for transfer of appropriations No DEC 26/2015.

The purpose of this proposal is to transfer an amount of EUR 15 million in commitment and payment appropriations from Article 01 03 02 (*Macro-financial assistance*) to Article 23 02 01 (*Delivery of rapid, effective and needs-based humanitarian aid and food aid*), as recorded in document 11751/15 FIN 590.

- 2. The transfer is being proposed in order to provide humanitarian assistance to respond to the increased needs in the crisis in South Sudan, for an amount of EUR 15 million.
- 3. The <u>Budget Committee</u> examined this proposal for a transfer at its meeting on 10 September 2015.

- 4. Following that examination, the <u>Budget Committee</u> agreed, by a qualified majority, to suggest that the Permanent Representatives Committee advise the Council to approve:
  - the proposed transfer of appropriations;
  - the draft letter in the ANNEX to that effect.
