Subject:	COMMISSION DELEGATED REGULATION (EU) .../... of 28.7.2015 supplementing Regulation (EU) No 952/2013 of the European Parliament and of the Council with regard to detailed rules of specifying some of the provisions of the Union Customs Code - Intention not to raise objection to a delegated act

---

1. The Commission submitted the above delegated act<sup>1</sup> to the Council in accordance with the procedure set out in Article 290 TFEU and Regulation (EU) No 952/2013 of the European Parliament and of the Council laying down the Union Customs Code<sup>2</sup>, and in particular its Article 284(2) thereof. The Commission having notified the delegated act on 21 August 2015, the Council may object to it until 21 October 2015.
2. The Customs Union Working Party was consulted and no delegation considered that there would be grounds for the Council to object to it.

3. It is therefore suggested that Coreper recommend that the Council confirm that it has no intention to object to the above mentioned delegated act and that the Commission and the European Parliament are to be informed thereof. This implies that, unless the European Parliament objects to it, the delegated act shall be published and enter into force in accordance with Article 284 of Regulation (EU) No 952/2013.
