1.5. This report has been drafted in co-operation of the expert team members:

- in line with the conclusions of 20 September 2001 in which the JHA-Council emphasised "the important role of the Security and Intelligence services in the fight against terrorism" and that the "co-operation between the police services, including Europol, and the intelligence services will have to be strengthened",
- within the frame of the remit of the evaluation as laid down in the decision of the Article 36 Committee,
- on the basis of the documents mentioned above, particularly the Spanish answers to both questionnaires,
- on the basis of the presentations and additional documents given during the visit on site and as result of the discussions.
