Subject:	Draft Council Implementing Decision on the launch of automated data exchange with regard to dactyloscopic data in Sweden

1. The Working Party on Information Exchange and Data Protection (DAPIX) approved at its meeting on 18 February 2015 the evaluation visit report on dactyloscopic data exchange for Sweden (5971/15 JAI 69 DAPIX 18 CRIMORG 17 ENFOPOL 32 ENFOCUSTOM 7), and at its meeting on 8 June 2015 the overall report (5981/15 JAI 72 DAPIX 19 CRIMORG 18 ENFOPOL 33 ENFOCUSTOM 8) based on the questionnaire, an evaluation visit and a pilot run.
2. At the DAPIX meeting of 8 June 2015, it was acknowledged that each Member State bound by Decision 2008/615/JHA agrees that the conditions are fulfilled for the Council to conclude that for the purposes of automated data exchange with regard to dactyloscopic data, Sweden has fully implemented the general provisions on data protection of Chapter 6 of Decision 2008/615/JHA.

3. Consequently, the Council adopted on 13 July 2015 the draft Council Conclusions on the implementation of the general provisions on data protection of Chapter 6 of Council Decision 2008/615/JHA ("Prüm Decisions") concerning Sweden with regard to automated exchange of dactyloscopic data (10194/15 JAI 496 DAPIX 112 CRIMORG 74 ENFOPOL 174 ENFOCUSTOM 68).
4. As required by the applicable Treaty provisions, the Council decided on 22 July 2015 to consult the European Parliament on the draft Council Implementing Decision on the launch of automated data exchange with regard to dactyloscopic data in Sweden, as finalised by the Legal/Linguistic Experts and set out in 10027/15 JAI 475 DAPIX 106 CRIMORG 69 ENFOPOL 163 ENFOCUSTOM 60.
5. The European Parliament gave its opinion on 27 October 2015.
6. *On this basis, COREPER is requested*
  - *to submit the overall report (5981/15) to the Council, and*
  - *to invite the Council to adopt as an "A" item on its agenda the draft Council Implementing Decision on the launch of automated data exchange with regard to dactyloscopic data in Sweden (10027/15)*
