Subject:	Draft Council Decision on the financial contributions to be paid by the Member States to finance the European Development Fund in 2015, including the 3rd instalment 2015 - Adoption

1. On 23 October 2015, the Commission submitted to the Council a proposal for a Council Decision on the financial contributions to be paid by the Member States to finance the European Development Fund concerning the third instalment for 2015<sup>1</sup>.
2. Under Article 57(5) of the Financial Regulation applicable to the 10th European Development Fund (EDF)<sup>2</sup>, the Council shall decide on the proposal at the latest 21 calendar days following the presentation by the Commission, and the Member States must pay the third instalment of contributions at the latest 21 calendar days following the date on which the Council Decision was notified to them.
3. On 30 October 2015, the ACP Working Party agreed on the financial contributions to be paid by the Member States to finance the European Development Fund in 2015, including the 3rd instalment 2015, as set out in the Commission proposal.
