Subject:	European External Action Service's request for prior approval to finance a building acquisition project throught a loan

1. On 29 October 2015, the European External Action Service submitted to the Council a request for prior approval to finance a building acquisition project through a loan, in accordance with Article 203(8) of the Financial Regulation.

This request concerns the purchase of the EU delegation building in Tokyo. The denomination of the contract in JPY exposes the EEAS to an important exchange rate risk. The EEAS would like to eliminate this risk and at the same time obtain improved financial conditions based on the current low interest rates prevailing within the euro zone by obtaining a loan under the credit line at the disposal of the EEAS since March 2015.

2. The Budget Committee examined this request at its meeting on 3 November 2015.

- 3. Following that examination, the Budget Committee agreed, by qualified majority, to suggest that the Permanent Representatives Committee advise the Council to approve:
 - the request of the European External Action Service to complete the purchase of the EU
 delegation building in Tokyo through a loan;
 - the draft letter in the ANNEX to that effect.
