Subject:	2015 Report of the SME Envoy Network to the Competitiveness Council
	- Information from the Commission

The Competitiveness Council of September 2013 decided to improve the monitoring of SME-related policies through the network of SME Envoys. It invited the Envoys to report on a regular basis on the progress achieved in implementing the Small Business Act (SBA) and other initiatives relevant to SMEs.

The first report, which gave an overview of the activities of the Network was presented to the Competitiveness Council in December 2014.

The report for 2015:

- presents an overview of the latest trends in the performance of the EU SMEs,
- summarises the work done on four priorities: SME test in impact assessment, access to finance, reduction of administrative burden and entrepreneurship and
- presents an outline for the activities of the SME Envoy network in 2016 and beyond.
