**Declaration from the Republic of Poland in the context of Article 36(2) of Council  
Decision 2008/615/JHA of 23 June 2008**

In accordance with Article 36(2) of Council Decision 2008/615/JHA of 23 June 2008 on the stepping up of cross-border cooperation, particularly in combating terrorism and cross-border crime, the Republic of Poland declares that it has implemented the obligations imposed under the abovementioned Decision and will apply immediately the Decision in its relations with all other Member States which have given the same notification.

The Republic of Poland has implemented Council Decisions 2008/615/JHA of 23 June 2008 and 2008/616/JHA of 23 June 2008 with regard to the exchange of Vehicle Registration Data and DNA profiles in 2012 respectively, and with regard to dactyloscopic data in 2015.

In accordance with Article 19 of Council Decision 2008/616/JHA, the independent data protection authority is the Polish Inspector General for the Protection of Personal Data.

The remaining declarations provided for in Decision 2008/615/JHA have already been notified to the General Secretariat of the Council.
