Georgios Shammias



Georgios Shammias assumed his duties as Chairman of Cyprus Energy Regulatory Authority (CERA) in February of 2010 for a 6 years term, successfully addressing challenges to the energy sector and steering the latter through its reform and reformation.

Georgios Shammias is currently the candidate nominated by the Government of Cyprus for the Administrative Board of ACER (Agency for the Cooperation of Energy Regulators).
